COVID-19 Clubhouse and Golf Course Procedures

With the overall health and well-being of our members, guests, and employees as our top priority during this time, please take a moment to read through the procedures for our golf course and clubhouse.

 TEE TIMES/CHECKING IN

- Tee time intervals will remain 10 minutes apart.
- Reservations may be made by using the mobile app, or by calling the Pro Shop @ 701-772-3912
- No more than 2 people allowed in Pro-Shop, other than staff.

 PUB, DINING ROOM, AND GREEN ROOM RESTAURANTS

- The Green Room will be open for service with limited seating available and we will have patio tables and chairs set-up outside the green room.
- Please call the clubhouse when you are on the 8/17 tee to place a food order. This will allow the staff enough time to prep your meal.
- The Pub will be open for up to 20 people at one time.
- The Dining Room is closed until further notice.

 RESTROOMS

- All restrooms will be available for use and will be cleaned 3-4 times a day.
- The Porta-Potty's on the golf course (behind 4 green and 13 green) will be cleaned three times daily.

 GOLF CARTS and PUSH CARTS

- Keys will be left in carts to eliminate extra touchpoints and the need to visit the Pro Shop.
- **One rider per cart unless you live together. This will be done to help ensure social distancing. This policy may be lifted by the NDDoH in the future.**
- Carts will be cleaned and disinfected after each use. This will include a thorough wipe down of all high-touch areas.
- Push carts will be available for use, we simply ask that you return the cart to the cart washing area so we can wipe it down before putting it back out for use.
- Sand/Seed bottles and Coolers will be available.
- Scorecard and Pencils will not be placed on carts. Rather, we suggest you download the 'Easy Score Golf' app to track your scores.
- Towels will be available.

 DRIVING RANGE

- Range balls will still be available to hit.

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(Driving Range continued)

- Balls will be stacked using the pyramids so our guests do not have to touch anything.
- Pyramids will be placed 8' apart to ensure social distancing.
- Balls will be washed using a detergent mixed with a disinfectant.

 GOLF COURSE

- No ball washers will be placed on the course.
- No bunker rakes will be placed on the course. Please do your best to make a smooth surface with your foot. The Grounds Crew will mechanically rake the bunkers throughout the week.
- No water jugs will be placed on the golf course.
- We will still be putting cups with flags in the greens, using a pool noodle to stop the ball from dropping in all the way. **Please do not pull the flagstick out.**

 HOLING OUT & POSTING SCORES TO GHIN HANDICAP

- Your ball is considered holed when it *fairly* strikes near the center of the cup. Golf balls that nick the sides of targets are not fairly holed and should proceed being puttied until truly and fairly holed.
- You may post scores to your handicap using the 'Most Likely Score' procedure in the rules.

'Most Likely Score' under Rule 3.3 of the Rules of Handicapping book:

When a player starts a hole but does not hole-out for a valid reason, subject to other provisions set out within the *Rules of Handicapping*, the player must record their most likely score or net double bogey, whichever is lower, as appropriate for the situation and depending on the format of play.

- o The *Most Likely Score* is:
 - The number of strokes already taken to reach a position on a hole, plus
 - The number of strokes the player would most likely require to complete the hole from that position, plus
 - Any penalty strokes incurred during play of the hole.
- o Add 1 additional stroke if – your ball lies on the putting green, no more than 5 feet from the hole.
- o Add 2 or 3 additional strokes if – your ball lies between 5 feet and 20 yards from the hole.
- o Add 3 or 4 additional strokes if – your ball lies more than 20 yards from the hole.
